

# Adrian Dual-Degree Engineering Program Summaries

## **ELECTRICAL ENGINEERING** (AC contact: Dr. Greg Thompson)

Students will receive a **B.A. in Physics from Adrian**, and a **B.S. in Electrical Engineering from University of North Dakota (UND)**

Completing this program will take about 5 years (10 semesters) at a total of 147 credit hours. 75 from Adrian; 72 from UND. Students start taking UND courses during the fall of their freshman year. *(reference the program map for more info)*

**All UND courses are offered online. No in-person labs required.**

## **CIVIL ENGINEERING** (AC contact: Dr. Greg Thompson)

Students will receive a **B.A. in Physics from Adrian**, and a **B.S. in Civil Engineering from University of North Dakota (UND)**

Completing this program will take about 5 years (10 semesters) at a total of 168 credit hours. 88 from Adrian; 80 from UND. Students start
